We're currently in the midst of GCSE examinations, and our senior school teachers have been hosting subject-specific revision sessions to support our pupils.



To honour Deafness Awareness week, the children have been learning basic sign language. During a group discussion Green Group established that we use our mouths to communicate by talking and our listening ears to hear what we are saying to each other. The children discovered different ways to communicate, by smiling to indicate happiness and using different facial expressions to demonstrate their feelings, we talked about using phones and computers to send messages to others and using sign language greetings to say hello, good and thank you. The children also learned how to sign the initial of their names.

In Year 2 & Year 3...

Pupils celebrated Deaf Awareness Week with fun activities. Year 2 have been watching British sign language videos and trying out some of the actions. They also explored sign language for animals and colours. Year 3 pupils also learned sign language, practicing the alphabet and simple words. They used their new skills to sign their names and play guessing games. The experience helped everyone appreciate communication in all its forms.







Over in Year 7...

Pupils celebrated Deaf Awareness Week to help raise awareness and to highlight what we could do to support those around us who may have difficulty with hearing. In Senior School, Year 7 pupils; Oliver L and Shaan D created and confidently presented an assembly to all staff and pupils which was also shared with the prep school.

The assembly helped pupils understand the challenges faced by people who are deaf and to recognise that patience, empathy and tolerance goes a long way in making everyone feel included.

MUMMY'S HEAD WORKSHOP

This week a historian from Sandwell Museum visited Year 4 with a selection of Egyptian artefacts. Pupils discussed what the artefacts could have been made from, what they may have been used for and who may have used it. There was even a real -life mummified head! Though, not everyone wanted to get too close!

The children saw jewellery made from faience clay, a pumice stone, a decorative scarab beetle, a wooden pillow, a wooden lid for a canopic jar in the shape of Anubis, as well as even more replica items.

They discussed whether the objects may have belonged to rich or poor people in Ancient Egypt, based on the type of materials the objects were made from. Pupils also decided whether the item would have been decorative or whether it had a specific use, searching for clues to support their predictions. Year 4 were excellent detectives and historians, making predictions based on prior knowledge. The workshop was interesting, memorable and brought learning to life!

Mathematics Workshop






