Course overview

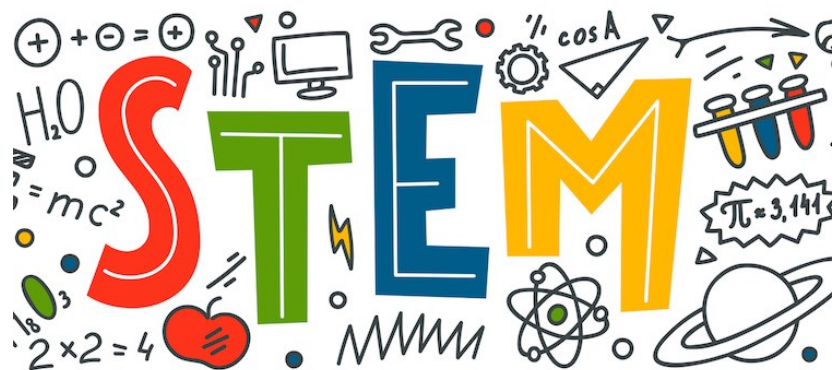
Give back to your school community by reading with Prep school pupils. You will improve your own communication skills, as well as giving younger pupils the courage and confidence they need to become independent readers.

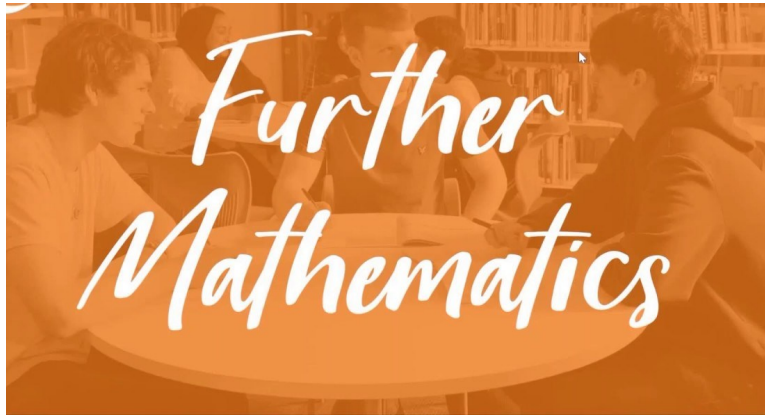
Do you have a passion for creating unique and wonderful things with a needle and thread?

Pupils will get the chance to learn various types of stitches and unleash your creativity!

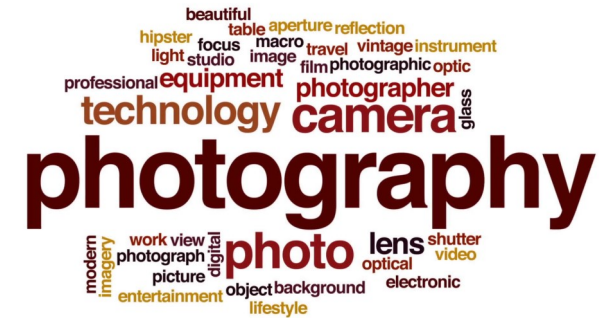

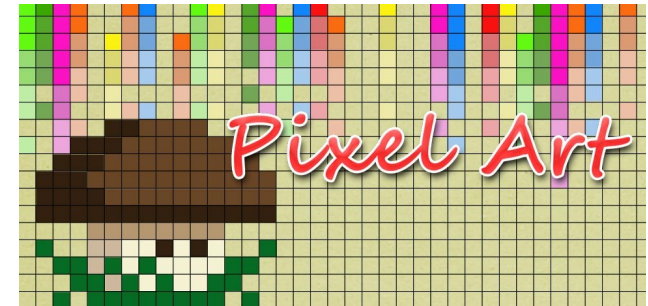


Spark your creativity....Play Chess
